Central Western Maine Workforce Development Board Access Guide for referring clients to WIOA partner programs

Pursuant to 20 CFR 678.500, CWMWDB's MOU must include methods to ensure the needs of workers, youth, and individuals with barriers to employment are addressed by providing access to WIOA partners and services. Ways to provide "access" include:

Option 1: Having a partner program staff member physically present at the comprehensive one- stop center(co-location);

<u>Option 2</u>: Having a staff member from a different partner program physically present at the comprehensive one-stop center who is appropriately trained to provide information to customers about the partner's programs, services, and activities; or <u>Option 3</u>: Making available a "direct linkage" through technology to a program staff member who can provide meaningful information or services.

- A "direct linkage" means providing direct connection at the comprehensive one-stop center, within a reasonable time, by phone or through a real-time Web-based communication, to a partner program staff member who can provide program information or services to the customer.
- A "direct linkage" cannot exclusively be providing a phone number, a website address, or printed pamphlets or materials; it means a direct linkage to a partner program staff person.

Bureau of Employment Services (BES) staff cover the reception area at the Lewiston Career Center, CWMWDB's Comprehensive One Stop Center. Staff can directly connect people with any partner co-located on site or offer assistance by appropriately connecting to all partners through the processes outlined below.
